Dear Family and Friends,

As we approach Thanksgiving, we pray that you are finding many reasons to thank the Lord even in the midst of the continuing pandemic. We personally are very grateful for His many blessings since we last wrote to you in August.



First of all, we praise God that we have reached the funding goal for our mission service in Chile next spring. Thank you all so much for your generous contributions. At this time we no longer need to raise more funds.

We also thank the Lord for the growing number of people who have committed to pray for us while we serve in Chile.

Chile is beginning to open up again, and Godwilling we will be able to travel in March and serve in Santiago from March through May.

We are also thankful that until now we have had no illness in our family, and we have been able to see our children and grandchildren in Southern California. We've even had road trips to Arizona, Utah, and Texas.

Finally, we are thankful that the Lord has given us the opportunity to return to Liberia in January through the mission of our home congregation, Faith Community Lutheran here in Las Vegas. Barb will be teaching several Bible courses to women and high school students for three weeks, and Bo will be doing pastoral training for five weeks. As of right now, we are scheduled to leave for Liberia on January 4th.
