While we aren't going to go into the whys or why nots of this situation here, we do have a question for everyone who reads this newsletter to ponder and pray. It is truly a burden of our hearts that weighs heavily.

We are fairly sure many of you will recall our talking about how God 'called us' to do this ministry, something we had never done before. He showed us a vision, instilled in us a passion, and sent us off half way around the world to a place neither of us had ever been, doing something we figured we'd never be able to do. It started all with a simple call at that point. It was actually the future calling us to 'answer the phone.'

We could have said 'no thanks.'

Remembering so much of the uncertainty during those days, we truly moved out on a leap of faith as a couple. It wasn't easy for us. Some days even now it still remains a challenge. But what about everyone else out there in our camp? Have you thought much
