~Vision: Be Fruitful to please God

~Mission

~The mission of Immanuel Lutheran Church is to reach all of the Cambodian people for Christ and from this fruit to send laborers to reach the khmer speaking people surrounding Cambodia (i.e. Vietnam, Thailand, Singapore, Korea, France, Australia, Malaysia, Canada, and the US).

~Cell Group planting: Historically the evangelist focused on winning individuals to Christ. Peter

Wagner observed that church planting was the most effective method.

~Goal: our goal is to plant a cell group in every village, commune, city, and town of 2045. ILC is all so committed to help, join, and cooperate with other Christians from overseas local in God's Kingdom of Wonder.

~Emphasis of Ministry: To fulfill the great commission, the ILC needs to focuses on practical help and training. Theology is important, but living the simple Gospel, get the job done. The people of Cambodia have suffered too long, to compassion from generation to generation; especially, in 3 years 8 months and 20 days of Pol Pot regime are National Inter-Great of Historical known. Their message must be one of forgiveness, love, and help.

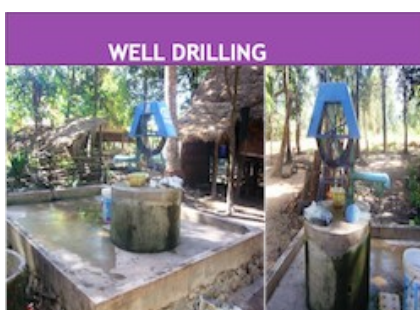
~Strategies: to make our goal and objective completed, we establish the following points:
Training Projects: Ministry training Center located in Siem Reap Angkor. The school provides a one-year curriculum for students who have been called into full time-ministry. Each year we anticipate we enrolling up 12-24 students.

~The training concentrates on three goal: First, to provide each student with a firm understand of basic Christian beliefs and solid of Bible (especially, the four Gospels, Acts, Romans, Ephesians). To guide the students into a fuller experience of God, allowing them to experience the joy their lives. And last to provide the students the opportunity in the context of cell group churches practical training in evangelism and cell church ministry consider with academics.
National Pastor Training Seminars: We are currently scheduling six 3-day seminars a year, alternating between three major regions of the

country. The seminars make it possible for leaders and those of Christian servants around the world.

~Every three months meetings in Snor Village, Lavea Commune, Pouk District, Siem Reap Cambodia are administrative in nature but also help to equip our church pastors too.

Evangelism: Jesus film, Women in need, well drilling. Pastoral Training Meeting: Mobile Health clinic, Humanitarian help.
