



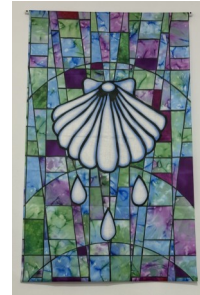

The system is American made (filters) and the exact same one I have in my own stateside home, so I was fortunate to come with some knowledge base of what was going on. This is on a much larger scale. The tank holds 3000L of water. The old one is 1500L.

The other photo is next to the white board in the classroom. Water from the main system flows around the back of the house and gets a second filtering here and then the spigot that is outside can be turned on for drinking water.

We also added in a washing station outside the toilet and a separate male facility.
